<b>PARTICIPATION AND AGE LIMITS</b>	ND 1 (6-8), ND 2 (9-11), AG 1 (12-14), AG 2 (15-17), Seniors (18 and older)		
<b>REGISTRATION DEADLINES</b>	Provisional registration	11 <sup>th</sup> January 2018	2 months prior to the event
	Nominative registration	11 <sup>th</sup> February 2018	1 month prior to the event
<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	The Entry Fees for this event will be: - EUR 20,00 for IW / IM - EUR 30,00 for MP - EUR 45,00 for TRIO - EUR 60,00 for GROUP - EUR 70,00 for AERO DANCE/AERO STEP		
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	The accreditation will take place at the Kaunas. Delegations accreditation will take place upon arrival. For accreditation the head of delegation is required to bring the following documents: - passports of all members of the delegation - proof of medical insurance of all members of the delegation - CD with music for the programs (2 copies of each routine+1 copy keep for training) - all delegations must deliver its flag		
<b>COMPETITION FORMAT</b>	Each competitor can participate in max 3 categories. Qualifications and finals will be carried out in each category. The 8 best scores per category (max. 1 per federation for GR, resp. 2 for Individual Men, Individual Women, Mixed Pairs and Trios) may participate in the finals. Aero Dance and Aero Step: only the finals (AG1, AG2 and Seniors categories).		
<b>PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE</b>	-8 <sup>th</sup> of March, 2018 Arrival day delegations, Podium training possibility, Orientation Meeting, Judges Meeting -9 <sup>th</sup> of March, 2018 Qualifications in categories ND1, ND2, AG1, AG2, SEN -10 <sup>th</sup> of March, 2018 Finals in all categories, Competition and gala (evening) -11 <sup>th</sup> of March, 2018 Departure		
<b>MEDICAL SERVICES</b>	Medical services will be provided by the Organizing Committee during training and competition. A physiotherapist and medical team will be present during the competitions and trainings. Medical support is also available at the city Hospital.		
<b>VISA</b>	The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 11 <sup>th</sup> February 2018 to the LOC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, home address, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.		
<b>INSURANCE</b>	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.		
<b>INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	The invited Participating Federations/Clubs must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the Organizing Committee by 11 <sup>th</sup> February 2018. 2018.		
<b>LOCAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	Organizers will provide transportation from Vilnius airport, Vilnius railway and bus stations to the hotel and the competition venue.
