FORMAT	ORMAT For both IAF and FIG, participation is limited to 2 per country in each category, maximum total 4 from one country. In case that there are less than 4 gymnasts/units from both IAF and F per category as of Definitive Registration on February 21 2018, to respective category will be cancelled. Finals: The 2 bests will qualify for the Finals irrespective of their origin (IAF or FIG). In case that the actual number of routines on the Qualification day is less than 1 for each category, then the number of routines for the Finals for each category we be determined based on the number of gymnasts/units in the Qualifications:			
	In addition, if the organizing member country has not qualified in any categories in AG, the organizing member country may nominate one participation in max. 1 category of its choice.			
	Maximum participation in the Finals is therefore 8+1 participants in 1 category a 8 in the other categories. Such "Wild Card Participant" must have participated the respective category in the qualification.
