Trios are listed **by name**, but considered **as an entity**. One change of name in a Trio is allowed, but in case of a second change of name, the Trio is considered as a new Trio.

Groups are listed by Federation. The World Cup Points are assigned to the Federation. If more than one Group per Federation starts at an event, only the better result will be considered.
