COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>The Competitions consist of Qualifications and Finals.</p> <p>■ <u>Qualifications:</u> For both IAF and FIG, participation is limited to 2 per country in each category, maximum total 4 from one country.</p> <p>In case that there are less than 4 gymnasts/units from both IAF and FIG per category as of Definitive Registration on February 21 2018, the respective category will be cancelled.</p> <p>■ <u>Finals:</u> The 2 bests will qualify for the Finals irrespective of their origin (IAF or FIG). In case that the actual number of routines on the Qualification day is less than 12 for each category, then the number of routines for the Finals for each category will be determined based on the number of gymnasts/units in the Qualifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If 12 and more per category: 8 Finalists - Between 8 - 11: 6 Finalists only - If less than 8: 4 Finalists only <p>In addition, if the organizing member country has not qualified in any categories in AG, the organizing member country may nominate one participation in max. 1 category of its choice.</p> <p>Maximum participation in the Finals is therefore 8+1 participants in 1 category and 8 in the other categories. Such "Wild Card Participant" must have participated in the respective category in the qualification.</p>
